


# THE UNIVERSAL EXPOSITION OF 1904

As President of the Louisiana Purchase Exposition, David R. Francis was in a unique position to write a definitive summary of the Fair. Volume 2 contains chapters with extensive details about the award and construction of the Fair, the buildings and thousands of exhibits in each of the 16 'departments', the Fair itself (music, sculptures, special events and days), concessions, and the salvage and destruction of the Fair. Volume 2 features 155 pictures of the Fair, printed on high-quality paper, including several 1/2 page pictures of Model City, very few interior exhibit pictures, and no pictures of paintings. Includes some pictures of Jefferson History Museum (built in 1913), financial summary statements from the Fair, and listings of personnel of all Fair organizations. Note: Sold as Set Only
