40 Years of Books - YMCA Book Fair

Book lovers and collectors ready for yearly pilgrimage to one of the Midwest's largest book fairs with proceeds benefitting youth and literacy programs

St. Louis, MO (Aug. 1, 2018) – The Gateway Region YMCA is gearing up for its 40th Annual Book Fair August 17-21 at the Greensfelder Recreation Complex in Queeny Park. The fair features more than half a million books, CDs, magazines, and records. Proceeds benefit the Y's youth and literacy programs that provide reading tutoring and free books to hundreds of children and adults each year.

"Each year, more than 2,000 children and adults are served by literacy programs thanks to the funds raised from the Book Fair," said Caroline Mitchell, executive director of the Community Development YMCA. "Programs we offer include parent workshops that provide free books to families, English as a Second Language class and tutoring for adults, and early learning readiness and child development programs for caregivers and children."

The Y Read program, which provides one-on-one tutoring for children who are reading below their grade level, has been shown to improve reading levels by two grades! An average of 125 children received free reading tutoring through the program per year.

The fair includes a rare books collection, including a signed copy of Danse Macabre, first edition by Stephen King, Charlie Brown's 'Cyclopedia as a 15 volume set, and a signed copy of Aretha from These Roots, from Aretha Franklin herself.

Preparation for the event began in March thanks to the generous people of the entire bi-state region who donated their materials to one of the Y's 24 branches. Approximately 400 volunteers and 8,000 volunteer hours go into putting on one of the region's largest and most popular fairs.
