YMCA of Greater St. Louis Names Afshanti Hunter as 2014 Joseph P. Sunnen Youth of the Year

Youth of the Year winners will receive scholarships from Lindenwood University

St. Louis, MO (March 6, 2014) – The YMCA of Greater St. Louis today announced the 2014 Joseph P. Sunnen Youth of the Year winner – Afshanti Hunter, 17, of Florissant. Along with 16 branch winners, Hunter will be presented with her award at the annual Youth of the Year Awards Dinner on Thursday, March 6.

The award recognizes young people who demonstrate exceptional leadership skills, volunteer their time to the Y and their communities, and exemplify the Y's core values – caring, honesty, respect, responsibility and faith.

"At the Y, we are honored to work with so many young people who are on their way to making a lasting difference in their communities through leadership, volunteerism and other contributions," said Gary Schlansker, president and CEO of the YMCA of Greater St. Louis. "We are proud of Afshanti and all of the Youth of the Year recipients on the initiative they have taken in bettering their communities. The Youth of the Year award has been awarded in partnership with Lindenwood University since 2004. Each year, the university generously awards a scholarship of approximately \$62,000 to the young person named the Joseph P. Sunnen Youth of the Year and approximately \$33,000 in scholarships to each of those selected Branch Youth of the Year.

Hunter is active at the Emerson Family YMCA through the Teen Leaders Club, Youth in Government and Counselor In Training programs, completing more than 175 hours of community service over the past four years.
