3 PM Stepping Stones \$25

Work with tiles of glass, ceramic and stone to create an image on concrete. Wait 1.5-2 days to pick up the stone from the art center.



SATURDAY

10 AM Pour Paint / Fluid Art \$20

Practice pour painting techniques on a 7in vinyl record before creating your piece on a full-size vinyl record or canvas. Requires use of gloves and to be left overnight to dry. Ready for pickup 9AM next day.

11 AM Ice Dye Fabric Price varies

Tie and dye your fabric canvas using chemical reactions between ice and powder dyes, resulting in watercolor like patterns. This project includes an overnight chemical reaction and will be ready for pick up at 9am the next day. Requires the use of gloves and masks. Recommended ages 7+

3 PM Candle Making \$20

Select your candle mold design, paint with your chosen colors of mica powder, and pour your candle with your chosen scented soy wax. This project has an overnight dry time and will be ready for pick up next day at 9AM. Requires use of gloves, masks, and goggles. Recommended ages 8+
